DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

- 1) Janes addressed the Committee regarding the request for the York/Valette Business Association for a Farmers Market. Subsequent to a brief discussion the Committee signed the report.
- 2) The Committee reviewed the draft report and discussed Staff recommendations to replace the existing two-way stop with a four-way stop intersection at York and Adelaide. Bram asked Hughes for clarification on the MUTCD criteria warranting the change to a four way stop intersection. Hughes advised that the accident count for the intersection justifies the change. Bram expressed concern with adequate line of sight when changed to a four way stop intersection. Hughes explained that the signs would be placed in such a way as to provide adequate line of sight, also that as a result of the Crescent Ct. project, the drive to Fifth Third Bank now aligns with Adelaide. Prior to Crescent Ct. this drive was offset to Adelaide. Subsequent to discussion the Committee signed the report.
- 3) Quigley addressed the Committee advising that as a result of increasing the size of the entertainment center and the additional revenue this would produce, he has been able to upgrade the entertainment venues for Elmfest.
