DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

Item #1 Chief Neubauer addressed the Committee regarding the Knights of Columbus request to create a new liquor license for special events or occasions. These events would be held at the Knights of Columbus and/or other bona fide social, fraternal, or religious organizations. The ordinance proposes to amend section 36.09 to add a Class "DL" liquor license classification. A Class "DL" license would limit the number of events to one hundred twenty (120) per year.

Chief Neubauer requested several requirements regarding the license;

- A list of event dates provided to the Clerk and Police Department a minimum of two weeks prior
- The bartenders and managers be B.A.S.S.E.T. trained & certified
- A background check on the liquor manager be conducted, prohibit the following:
 - (a) Free alcohol nights to members
 - (b) Bring your own alcohol events
 - (c) Donation events and if the building is open, no alcohol is to be served or consumed on the premises

During further discussion the Committee agreed with Chief Neubauer's requested requirements. Also, a meeting will be arranged with Chief Neubauer and Pete Alphini, Knights of Columbus representative, to discuss these requirements. A tentative date of Friday April 30, 2010 was set. The Committee directed Staff to change the date on the draft report and authorized their signatures to allow the report to be placed on the next councils consent agenda.

Item #2 Mr. Storino advised currently the liquor ordinance allows for a Specialty License listing number of locations. This temporary license allows for the serving and consumption of alcohol at the listed locations for special events. He requested a review of the current list to allow for any changes. During subsequent discussion Chief Neubauer suggested that a provision be created to add any new locations to the established list by approval of the City Manager and Chief of Police. The Committee concurred. Mr. Storino will prepare the current list for review.
