- Item #6 Bacidore & Panico addressed the Committee providing an informational over view of the "Smart911 system being offered to all Du Page County communities including Elmhurst residents. "Smart911" is an enhanced free service that allows citizens to input their personal, medical and household information into the 9-1-1 system so that it is available to emergency call takers and first responders if and when they need to call 9-1-1. This service also provides location information of the caller to the call taker to pass along to emergency responders. Also, the service is 100 % private and secure. This service is being paid for by the Du Page County Emergency System Board (ETSB). The city will be marketing this service to residents by way of the City's web site, direct mail in resident water bills, and press releases.
