DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

Item #1

Hanson was present to address and respond to the Committee's questions. The discussion then focused on allowing banners to be affixed to City light poles only on those streets that are contiguous to Immaculate Conception property (York, Church, Cottage Hill and Arthur St.) The banners would be for the purpose of celebrating Immaculate Conception High School's 75th anniversary. Subsequent to further discussion the Committee directed Staff to prepare a report permitting the banners for the next Council meeting agenda, and directed Hanson to coordinate with the Public Works Department as to the proper size and mounting systems for the banners.

Item #2

Mayor DiCianni addressed the Committee providing an overview of his letter regarding the creation of a new liquor license and fee for same due to the unique business plan of Angelo's three entities. The discussion then focused on the purchase of packaged beer and wine from the deli portion of the business as carry out, and allowing for the sale and consumption of alcohol from the restaurant portion while seated in the deli section and consuming food purchased from the deli or restaurant. Storino advised the Committee that the draft report can be modified to specifying the sale of packaged beer and wine from the deli, and allow for a customer to purchase and consume an alcoholic beverage while having their meal in the deli section of the business. Subsequent to further discussion the Committee directed Staff to draft a report for Angelo's newly created liquor license RPD L for a base fee of \$4,950.00 with specific language detailed in the above discussion.

Item #3

Subsequent to discussion the Committee signed the report.

Item #4

Tom Trosien and Tom Paravola were present to respond to the Committee's questions and provide a status report of the Adelaide parking deck configuration regarding parking allocation. Wagner noted it appeared that the employee spaces were under utilized while other designated spaces were full. Trosien advised that there has been some slow down in the utilization of employee spaces and that it is not unusual in the summer due to vacations. The parking deck allocation & configuration is routinely monitored for use. Both Trosien and Paravola agreed that there needs to be more time, a complete year, to evaluate the new configuration therefore have a good representative sample of use over a long period of time to accurately analyze the use and need of specific spaces. Trosien also noted the Adelaide parking deck is scheduled for repairs and maintenance beginning July 27th with an anticipated completion date of September 26th. Trosien also advised the Committee that a "pay by phone" system is being reviewed which would be implemented into our existing electronic parking system. This would allow for greater customer convenience. Wagner requested a monthly status update of the Central Business parking allocation be placed on the agenda. Subsequently there was a brief discussion regarding valet parking on South York Rd. which was an agenda item at the PA&S meeting on July 11, 2011.

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Item #5

Bacidore provided the Committee a status update regarding the stop sign request for the intersection of Oak and First St. Bacidore advised that the evaluation and placement of a stop sign would be conducted subsequent to completion of construction of the town homes.
