DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

1. Gorenstein and Battaglia addressed the Committee providing an overview of the Business plan and respond to questions from the Committee. Subsequent discussion focused on the concept of two different themed restaurants under one roof and only, “Nana’s Pastarante” having a liquor license. The other, “Nana’s Hot Dogs & Italian Beef” would not. The Committee and Chief Neubauer expressed concern the floor plan with open passage between the two themes would create an inherent difficulty in preventing alcohol taken to Nana’s Hot Dog side. Subsequent to further discussion, the Committee directed Battaglia and Gorenstein to revise the floor and business plan to reflect the open passage between both restaurants be controlled by a door, possibly glass, the ordering and service of alcohol would only be done by wait staff on “Nana’s Pastarante” side, then report back to the Committee in two (2) weeks.
3. (Note: Item #3 was taken out of order due to Coni Keating addressing another committee at that time). Chief Kopp addressed the Committee providing a brief history to date and an overview of the plan for Fire Station #2.
2. Keating addressed the Committee providing an overview of her submitted report concerning the “Traffic Calming Request Procedure” and survey results as to how it compared to other comparable DuPage County communities.
