DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

1. Mr. James addressed the Committee providing a map and a brief description of the Farmer's Market. The discussion focused on current signage and safe entrance and exit of the City's lot. Subsequent to discussion, it was decided to place barricades at the alley drive from Vallette which would only allow entry to the Farmer's Market. Exit would be from N/E portion of the lot. The barricades would be supplied by the York & Vallette Business Association, who would also be responsible to put them up and take them down on the Farmer's Market dates. The Committee also requested Staff review current signage.
