Discussion and Comments:

- Item 1 Spagnola and Libsch were present to address and respond to the Committee's questions. During the discussion they provided an overview of the business plan and the sale of alcohol. Subsequent to further discussion the Committee signed the report.
- Item 2 Doherty was present to provide an overview of the Elmhurst Park Districts request for a "Battle of the Bands" permit. The Addison Street parking lot was used for this event several years ago and staff reported no significant problems. The Committee suggested proper notification to adjacent businesses and residents. Subsequent to discussion the Committee signed the report.
- Item 3a Leahy and Burggleman, representatives of AT&T, were present to provide an overview of the project and respond to the Committee's questions. Kopp opened the discussion advising the Committee this agenda item was informational and no action was necessary. Leahy provided the Committee and Staff with a printed Power Point explaining the project. Leahy explained the purpose of the project is to improve the wireless network along the rail lines and commuter stations. This would be accomplished by the installation of equipment on Commonwealth Edison poles near the rail lines which will fill coverage gaps and dead spots in the network and enhance service.
- Item 3b Subsequent to review and a brief discussion the Committee signed the report.
- Item 3c Kopp addressed the Committee regarding a request from the YMCA to close First Street between Maple and Elm on December 3, 2011 from noon to midnight. The YMCA is hosting a "Blackhawk Road Show" fundraising event that day. Also, the Elmhurst Chamber of Commerce will be hosting a beer tent across the street from the YMCA during the event. Subsequent to further discussion the Committee directed Staff to prepare a draft report, work with the YMCA and Chamber for a licensing agreement and coordinate the plan with the Police and Fire Departments.
- Item 3d Wagner opened the discussion by reviewing a resident's request to install "Right turn only between 3-6 PM" signs at the intersections of Cottage Hill & Eggleston, Seminole & Prospect and Eggleston & Seminole. Subsequent to discussion the Committee directed Staff to further review the request and report back to the Committee.
