Chairman Morley called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Chairman Morley, with the concurrence of the Committee, moved Agenda Item #3 Public Comments, to the beginning of the meeting rather than the end of the meeting as shown on the agenda. Chairman Morley opened Public Comments for anyone in attendance who wanted to address the Committee. Mr. David Kleinhans stated that the York Community Advisory Council (YCAC) members are present to provide the Committee with an update on the use of Clarence D. East Field with the new sound and lighting systems. Chairman Morley stated that the YCAC group can provide this update under Other Business. There being no one in the audience who wanted to address the Committee under Public Comments, Chairman Morley closed the Public Comments portion of the meeting.

Agenda Item #1 – Request to Adopt a Bicycle Parking Ordinance

The Committee continued their discussion of the request from the Bike Task Force that the City of Elmhurst adopt a bicycle parking ordinance. Mr. Hoel explained that the Task Force is asking for this ordinance to address new commercial developments within the City.

After discussion, it was the consensus of the Committee to prepare a report requesting that the City Council authorize the Zoning and Planning Commission to hold a Public Hearing to discuss a proposed Zoning Ordinance Text Amendment to require bicycle parking in the C2 and C3 Commercial zoning districts.

Other Business –Mr. Gills briefed the Committee on the activities of the YCAC since the new lighting and sound systems were installed at the York High School Clarence D. East Field. Mr. Gills provided the Committee with the results of a survey conducted door to door in the neighborhoods surrounding the sports field. The Committee noted the good work that YCAC has done to resolve issues between the high school and the surrounding neighborhood.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:00 p.m.
