DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

- 1) Alderman Tranter addressed the Committee outlining the concerns of the residents affected by parking conditions surrounding York Community High School. The Chairman then invited residents in attendance to share their concerns, issues identified: Prevalence of multiple car families with different schedules, numerous residences with one car garages and short driveways, and workman on service calls. Residents remain concerned about street parking from high school students. Chairman noted that current parking restrictions are a result of issues brought to the Committee by residents. Alderman Braum addressed administrative issues of a permit program. Public safety resources required for enforcement currently compared to what would be required with a permit program were noted by Alderman Mulliner and confirmed by Chief Neubauer. The Chairman directed staff to evaluate the information provided by residents, research other options available including any available technology and report back. The Chairman thanked the residents in attendance and advised City staff would notify them when the Committee would next address this issue.

- 2) Mayor Marcucci addressed the Committee relating personal experience and community feedback he has received when these events occur. It was the consensus of the Committee that a protocol be established and the City Council create a policy for this issue. Attorney Spiroff advised insurance, hold harmless, and a fee to cover costs should be included. The Chairman directed staff to create a draft protocol and report back.
