DISCUSSION AND COMMENTS:

1. Subsequent to discussion, this item was tabled for review in three months.
2. Subsequent to a brief discussion, the Committee signed the report.
3. Subsequent to a brief discussion, the Committee signed the report.
4. Kopp and Spiroff addressed the Committee regarding AT&T not providing access to Elmhurst Community programming which is available from Comcast. The Committee was informed that the City intends to purchase the necessary equipment to provide a “live feed” of Community programs to both AT&T and Comcast in the near future, This will satisfy the City franchise agreement that both Comcast and AT&T provide public programming to customers.
5. Kopp advised the Committee subsequent to a request staff evaluated the intersection of Third and Emroy. Subsequent to this, modifications to existing school speed limit signs and pedestrian warning signage will be made.
6. a) Kopp informed the Committee subsequent to a request; the Engineering division performed an intersection study at Fremont and Evergreen Avenues. This request was for a stop or yield sign. None of the warrants were met.

b) Kopp and Bacidore advised the Committee of current expenditures for radio antennas on Fire Station #1, due to the remodel of the City’s Emergency Operations Center. This expenditure will be funded from the “Prime-Co” account. This account was provided to the City of Elmhurst, ear marked specifically for disaster preparedness. Subsequent to further discussion, the Committee directed staff to draft a memo for Council summarizing the Prime-Co account funds and expenditures.
