Dear Chairwoman Juracek:

The City of Elmhurst has been very engaged in the runway rotation discussion since our joining the ONCC in September of 2016. At the same time that the ONCC approved our membership, the Ad Hoc Committee on Fly Quiet was formed. Due to this timing, Elmhurst was not afforded the opportunity to be appointed to this ad hoc committee.

We have taken advantage of attending the ad hoc meetings to observe, however we feel Elmhurst should "have a seat at the table" for the discussions and decisions on runway rotation. It does not appear that any communities on the diagonals of 4R/22L have been appointed to the committee.

We respectfully request to be appointed to the Ad Hoc Committee without delay so we can evaluate, give feedback and formally engage in the decision making process of an interim runway rotation plan.

If that is not possible, then we request this process be halted (evaluation and vote on a runway rotation plan for the interim period) until the Ad Hoc By-Laws Committee can go about their business to make Fly Quiet a standing committee. We understand the Ad Hoc By-Laws Committee has been tasked with evaluating the permanency of the Ad Hoc Fly Quiet Committee, however the timing of their process may not allow for communities on the diagonal runways to have a vote in the recommendation to the full ONCC Board.

Please let us know of your decision as soon as possible so we can plan accordingly.
