Citizen's Police Academy 25th Session!

The Citizen's Police Academy is a 12-week program designed to give citizens a better understanding of their local police department as well as some general Law Enforcement topics.

The program is free of charge and is limited to 25 students per session. Participants must be over the age of twenty-one and live or work in the City of Elmhurst.

Classes are held at the Elmhurst Police Station, 125 E. First Street.



One block of instruction is offered on consecutive Wednesday evenings from 6:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. for 12 weeks.

Sessions may include instruction on:

- Department Overview & History/Field Training
- Arrest, Search & Seizure Laws
- Investigation and Crime Analysis
- Evidence and Crime Scene Processing
- Internet Investigations
- Mission Team/Narcotics & K-9 Unit
- Interviewing and Interrogations
- DUI and Traffic Enforcement
- Elmhurst Fire Department Overview
- Range & Firearms Training
- Traffic Stops
- Emergency Response Team (ERT) & Crisis Negotiators

Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions, share hands-on experiences, and participate in some of the same training drills and procedures that our officers go through.
