The City will receive sealed proposals for the following improvements at the City Hall, 209 N. York Street, Elmhurst, IL 60126 until 10:00 a.m. on **July 16, 2019**.

CITY OF ELMHURST, IL HARRISON STREET STORM WATER PUMP STATION AND DETENTION BASIN IMPROVEMENTS

Proposals will be publicly read aloud after 10:00 A.M. on **July 16, 2019**. No bid shall be withdrawn after the opening of the proposals without the consent of the City for a period of forty-five days after the scheduled time of closing bids.

This project generally consists of the construction of new pumping equipment, VFD and miscellaneous improvements at the existing Harrison Street Storm Water Pump Station and new main flow pumps, backflow valve, new wet well and low flow pumps, underdrains and pump control panel at the Harrison Street Detention Basin.

A pre-bid meeting will be held at the Harrison Street Storm Water Pump Station on July 2, 2019, at 10:00 a.m., local time to tour the facility. The purpose of the pre-bid meeting is to allow Bidders to inspect the facility scheduled for improvements. The address of the pump station is adjacent the residence at 420 Harrison Street, Elmhurst, IL 60126.

All proposals shall be sealed in an envelope, addressed to the City of Elmhurst, attention Public Works Director. The name, address and phone number of the bidder and the name of the project shall also appear on the outside of the envelope. Proposals must be submitted on the forms provided by the Engineer.

Contractors must purchase bid documents and be shown on the Bidder's Planholder List in order to bid. Bids received from contractors who are not in the Bidder's Planholder List will be rejected.

A certified check/bank draft drawn on a solvent bank, payable without condition to the City of Elmhurst, or a bid bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid shall be submitted with each proposal as a guarantee that, if the proposal is accepted, a contract will be entered into and the performance of the contract is properly secured.

A Performance Bond and Payment Bond, each in a sum equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid with sureties to be approved by the City, must be furnished by the successful bidder. All bids or proposals shall contain an offer to furnish bonds upon acceptance of such bid or proposal.

Contractors and Subcontractors shall conform to the "Public Works Preference Project" Act, (30 ILCS 560/1, et Seq.)

Contractors shall be required to pay not less than the prevailing wage rates on the Project as established by the United States Department of Labor and the State of Illinois Department of Labor. Copies of these wage rates are incorporated in the Contract Documents.

Bids will only be received from qualified contractors. The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, to postpone the bid opening, or to advertise for new proposals, if in the judgment of the City their best interests will be promoted thereby.
