CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

ADELL & ADELAIDE PARKING DECK REPAIRS

The City of Elmhurst has entered into a contract with Western Waterproofing Co., Inc. of Chicago, IL to perform repair and maintenance work on the Adell Pl. & Adelaide Ave Parking Deck. This work includes miscellaneous pipe repairs, concrete repairs, joint repairs, cleaning and sealing of concrete floors, painting, and pavement striping. Parking decks are exposed to the elements, with the internal structural steel susceptible to corrosion from road salts. Regular routine maintenance of these facilities helps protect the steel, thereby extending the life of the structure and reducing the likelihood of major structural repairs in the future. **The Deck will remain open during construction operations.** Please be aware of the workers.

It will be necessary to close off parking spaces during operations. Miscellaneous repair work will require a minimum of 4 to 8 parking spaces per location to be barricaded off to perform repair activities. Several locations may be scheduled on the same day. Traffic will be maintained through the deck while work is underway.

Floor cleaning and concrete sealing will require an entire level of the parking deck to be closed at a time. Again, traffic will be allowed through the deck while work is underway. Generally, work will begin at the top level and progress to the lower levels.

Construction is anticipated to begin on Tuesday, October 1st and the project is anticipated to be complete in 6 weeks; although weather may influence the schedule. **Please consider alternate parking locations such as the Addison Parking Deck (149 N. Addison Avenue) during this time frame.**
