Social Distancing Violation / Cease and Desist Notice

The outbreak of COVID-19 has resulted in Illinois Governor Pritzker issuing a state disaster proclamation. Extraordinary measures have been taken by officials at the federal, state and local levels to protect the health, safety and welfare of citizens.

On March 21, 2020 Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-18 mandating that Illinois residents comply with the following:

- All Residents of the State of Illinois are being asked to stay at home and leave their homes only for essential activities, essential governmental function or to operate essential businesses and operations.
- When using shared or outdoor spaces outside of their residence, individuals are asked to maintain social distancing of at least six feet from any other person.
- All public and private gatherings of any number of people occurring outside of a single household or living unit, except for the limited purposes outlined in the executive order are prohibited.
- Under the guidance of the CDC, any gathering of more than ten people is prohibited unless exempted by this Executive Order
- All travel, including but not limited to, travel by automobile, motorcycle, scooter, bicycle, train, plane or public transit, except essential travel and essential activities as defined herein, is prohibited

The Governor’s Stay at Home Order is currently in place until April 30, 2020. The City of Elmhurst is asking residents to comply with the order for your safety and the safety of our community. Your failure to comply may result in enforcement including civil and/or criminal liability.

With many of our facilities shared between the City of Elmhurst, Elmhurst Park District and Elmhurst Community Unit School District 205, a community wide effort is being made to encourage residents of Elmhurst to abide by the Governor’s Executive Order. Please visit Elmhurst.org/ElmhurstStaysHome to see what your fellow residents are doing to stay positive while the Stay at Home Order is in place.
