**RECEIPT OF BIDS**

Sealed bids to complete all work required for the **Utley Stormwater Pump Station Rehabilitation** project will be received by the City of Elmhurst, DuPage County, Illinois until **11:30 a.m.**, (Central Daylight Savings Time) **on June 23, 2021**.

All sealed bids or packages must be brought to the Clerk's Office on the second floor of City Hall (209 N. York Street Elmhurst, IL 60126) no later than the designated bid time provided in the bid material.

Sealed envelopes or packages containing bids shall be marked **"Sealed Bid – Utley Stormwater Pump Station Rehabilitation, 19-35"**.

Thereafter or as soon as thereafter is practicable, all bids received will be opened and the bid prices read aloud via a **"teleconference call"**. Bidders can call in for the bid opening by dialing: 866-390-5250 using access code 9767449. Bidders are not required to participate in the bid opening themselves they can simply call or email **amanda.melone@elmhurst.org** for results 30 minutes past the time listed for the bid. **CONTRACT DOCUMENTS**

The work included in the base bid shall consist of rehabilitation of a 203 cfs stormwater pump station, including but not limited to, demolition of the existing pump station facilities; modifications to the existing pump station facilities; submersible axial flow pumps; variable frequency drives; level transducers; gate; safety grates; piping; valves; fittings; coatings; Submittal Exchange; diesel generator; automatic transfer switch; stormwater pollution preventive measures; excavation and disposal; backfill; landscaping; site restoration; dewatering; SCADA system integration and communications equipment; electrical; controls and appurtenances, Complete in Place. The work includes the installation of approximately 13,850 LF of fiber optic cable, conduit, pull boxes, restoration, and installation of fiber network equipment at 5 stormwater facilities. An alternate bid is included consisting of an additional approximately 6,400 LF of fiber optic cable, conduit, pull boxes, restoration, and installation of fiber network equipment at 2 additional stormwater facilities.

The bid documents are those prepared by Clark Dietz, Inc., 1815 S. Meyers Road, Suite 470, Oakbrook Terrace, IL 60126, and designated as **"Utley Stormwater Pump Station Rehabilitation"**. All submitted Bidding Documents shall be original copies obtained directly from Clark Dietz, Inc. Paper copies of the Bid Documents will not be made available.

Addenda notices will be made via email to the email address provided when downloading the plans. All Bidding Document holders must provide a name, phone number and email address to receive electronic addenda. Addenda will then be available for download from the Clark Dietz website.

Bid proposals must be submitted on the forms provided and in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders. Submission of a bid shall be conclusive assurance and warranty that the bidder has examined the plans, the site of the work and the local conditions affecting the contract and understands all of the requirements for performance of the work. The bidder will be responsible for all errors in its proposal resulting from failure or neglect to conduct an in-depth examination. The City of Elmhurst will in no case be responsible for any costs, expenses, losses or changes in anticipated profits resulting from such failure or neglect of the bidder. The bidder shall not take advantage of any errors or omission in the plans or proposal.

### **BID SECURITY**

Each bid shall be accompanied by a proposal guaranty in the form of a bid bond, executed by a corporate surety company, a bank cashier's check or a certified check payable to the City of Elmhurst for not less than ten percent (10%) of the amount bid. The proposal guaranty checks of all, except the two lowest responsible bidders will be returned after the proposals have been checked and tabulated. The proposal guaranty checks of the two lowest responsible bidders will be returned after the contract and the contract bond of the successful bidder have been properly executed and approved. Bid bonds will not be returned.

### **PRE-BID MEETING**

A Pre-Bid Meeting will be held on June 10, 2021 will be held at the City of Elmhurst Public Works Building, Lunch Room, 985 South Riverside Drive, Elmhurst, Illinois, 60126 at 9:00 A.M. CDT. This meeting is not mandatory but is recommended.

### **RIGHT TO REJECT BIDS**

The City of Elmhurst reserves the right to waive technicalities and to reject any and all proposals for any reason deemed in the best interest of the City of Elmhurst.

### **AWARD OF CONTRACT**

Unless all bids are rejected, the contract award will be made to the lowest responsive responsible bidder by July 7, 2021. In determining who the lowest responsive, responsible bidder is, the City of Elmhurst will consider all factors which it, in its discretion, deems relevant in determining who the lowest responsive, responsible bidder is.

### **PAYMENT OF PREVAILING WAGES**

The general prevailing rate of wages in DuPage County for each craft or type of worker or mechanic needed to execute the contract or perform the work, also the general prevailing rate for legal holiday and overtime work, as ascertained by the Illinois Department of Labor shall be paid for each craft or type of worker needed to execute the contract or to perform the work. Certified Payroll Records should be submitted to the Prevailing Wage Portal.
