BLOCK PARTY REQUEST FORM

ALL REQUESTS MUST BE MADE AT LEAST 10 DAYS BEFORE THE DATE OF THE PARTY. SHOULD WEATHER CAUSE A CANCELLATION, YOU WILL NEED TO CALL OR EMAIL CARMELLA TO RESCHEDULE.

FEASIBILITY OF BLOCK PARTIES WILL BE REASSESSED BASED ON THE LATEST SCIENCE AND PUBLIC HEALTH METRICS ON AN ONGOING BASIS. THE CITY MAY CEASE TO ISSUE OR REVOKE, BLOCK PARTY PERMITS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH CONSIDERATIONS, INCLUDING A REGRESSION FROM PHASE 4 OF THE RESTORE ILLINOIS PLAN.

<u>NOTE</u>: PARTIES CAN NOT BE MORE THAN 2 BLOCKS LONG. THE CITY RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DISAPPROVE BLOCK PARTY REQUESTS ON COLLECTOR ROADWAYS, WHICH HAVE HIGHER TRAFFIC VOLUMES AND CAN DISRUPT NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC FLOW.
